PIANTAGO LACHNANTHA BGE. (PLANTAGINACEAE), A NEW RECORD FOR FLORA OF IRAN

Plantago lachnantha Bge. collected from Kerman province is reported as a new record to Iran. This species is compared with closely related species, *Plantago evacina* Boiss.

گزارش گونه .Plantago lachnantha Bge برای اولین بار از ایران سعید محسنزاده، دکتر وحیده ناظری و سید منصور میرناجالدینی

گونه .Plantago lachnantha Bge که از استان کرمان جمع آوری شده است، برای اولین بار از ایران گزارش می گردد. این گونه با گونه مجاور خود .P. evacina Boiss مقایسه شده است.

Introduction

In the course of identification of unknown specimens of the genus *Plantago* in Bahonar University of Kerman Herbarium (KUH) *Plantago lachnantha* Bge. was found and is reported as a new record from Iran. The specimen is compared with its closest relative *P. evacina* Boiss.




Fig. 1. *Plantago lachnantha*. – A: habit, B: bract, C: sepals, D: corolla, E: seeds.

Plantago lachnantha Bge. -Fig. 1.

Kerman: Sirch to Shahdad, 1680 m, Mirtadzadini 1335 (KUH).

Annual, ca. 2 cm high, stem less with several or many floral scapes, which are shorter than leaves. Leaves 2-2.5 cm long and 1-1.5 mm wide, narrow and linear or lanceolate-linear, almost pubescent, margin entire, petioles 5-8 mm long. Puduncles densely tomentosepubescent, 0.8-1.5 cm long; spikes capitate, 3-5 mm in diameter. Bracts ovate, 4.25-4.5 mm long, with herbaceous midrib, broadly memberanous-edged, glabrous or less hairy. Sepals elliptic or ovate, 4-4.25 midrib, with herbaceous long, memberanous-edged, densely covered with long hairs. Corolla tube densely woolly-hairy, 1-1.25 mm long; corolla lobes oblong-ovate, glabrous, 1.25-1.5 mm

long. Seeds 2, elliptic or oblong-elliptic, about 2.5 mm, concave on one side, deeply concave on the other.

This species was reported in Flora Iranica (Patzak & Rechinger 1965) from Afghanistan and in Flora Orientalis (Boissier 1879) from Turkmenistan. Although the type specimen was not seen, details of its description were compared with different available Floras. According to the description given in Flora Iranica (Patzak & Rechinger 1965) and Flora Orientalis (Boissier 1879) Plantago lachnantha Bge. differs from P. evacina Boiss. in the following characteristics: In Plantago lachnantha Bge. peduncles are densely white tomentose-pubescent (not yellowish); green midrib excurrent to top as the bract (not greenish midrib no excurrent to top as the bract); sepals are herbaceous with green midrib and covered with densely long hair (not leathery with greenish midrib and woolly-hairy) and ovato-oblong petals (not ovato-lanceolate).
