A short morphological characters of this species are as follows. A bushy leafy woody-based herb, glandularly villous. Stems up to 50 cm long, branched. Leaves ovate, obtuse or acute, crenate-serrate in margins, rounded or truncate at the base. Flowers in lax leafy slender spikes or racemes. Calyx $\pm 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ long, sparsely hairy; lobes short, triangular, acute. Corolla violescent, 2-3 times as long as the calyx. Capsule pubescent.
