NOTES ON THE GENUS CARALLUMA R. BR. (ASCLEPIADACEAE) IN IRAN

The genus Caralluma represents in Iran by two indigenous species: C. edulis and C. tuberculata. Formerly only Caralluma edulis had been recorded from Iran. But a trip to the locality given for C. edulis in literature revealed that record of C. edulis in reality has been based on the specimen of C. tuberculata. Therefore the name C. tuberculata is used for the first time from Iran and C. edulis is recorded for the first time from Iran, correctly. A key to the species is given and the specimens seen by the author are mentioned.

بررسی جنس Caralluma در ایران

از جنس Caralluma در ایران ۲ گونه به نامهای C. edeulis (با نام محلی هوتک و آپی تک) و C. tuberculata (با نام محلی مغ مار و مارموتک) تشخیص داده می شود. قبلاً در منابع مختلف فقط گونه C. edulis از ایران گزارش شده بود. ولی با حضور در رویشگاه ذکر شده برای گونه C. edulis چنین نتیجه گیری شد که گزارش گزارش کونه ایران به طور اشتباه و براساس نمونههای C. tuberculata بوده است. بنابراین گونه C. وطulis درواقع برای اولین بار به طور صحیح از ایران گزارش می شود. کلید شناسایی گونهها ارائه و نمونههای دیده شده ذکر می گردد. هر ۲ گونه از مناطق جنوبی ایران جمع آوری شده اند.

Introduction

In a revision of the genus Caralluma R. Br. in Iran, herbarium materials were studied. The herbarium specimens had been named C. edulis (Edgw.) Benth. Further investigations revealed that these specimens are in reality C. tuberculata N. E. Brown and not C. edulis. Moreover, in Flora Iranica (Rechinger 1970) only C. edulis has been included. In at rip to the single Iranian locality of the species, herbarium materials were collected, but they were obviously C. tuberculata. However, true C. edulis also were collected. in a completely different habitat both in Hormozgan and Baluchistan provinces. In this paper notes are given for the two species and a key is prepared for them.




Fig. 1. Caralluma edulis (\times 0.56); flower (\times 2.8)

Caralluma edulis (Edgew.) Benth.-Fig. 1 Baluchistan: 95 km from Chahbahar to Iranshahr, Islamabad village, 170 m, Zaeifi & al. 75908; 100 km from Chahbahar to Iranshahr, Ghabulani village, 150 m, Zaeifi & al. 75909. -Hormozgan: Bandarabbas, Chahfaleh, 50 m, Zaeifi 20450; Bandarabbas, between Chahfaleh and Gowdov, 20 m, Zaeifi & Hajebi 2044.

Caralluma edulis was recorded in Flora

Iranica (Rechinger 1. c.) from Iran by a single specimen. This specimen obviously has not been seen by the author of Flora Iranica. The specimen was not traceable, but in the same locality only *C. tuberculata* was collected. Therefore, the identification of the above mentioned specimen is questionable and most probably, it should be in reality *C. tuberculata*.

C. edulis has local names of Howtak and Apitak in S. Iran. It is distributed from India through Pakistan, Afghanistan and Iran to Arabia. It grows on dunes, in young stage edible.

Caralluma tuberculata N. E. Brown. -Fig. Ghahrem, Fl. de l'Iran, Plate 1408 under the name C. edulis.

Baluchistan: Saravan, Bamposht, Mindar, 1470 m, Zaeifi & al. 75910. -Hormozgan: Genu mnt., 1320 m, Zaeifi & al. 75915; 50 km N. W. of Hajiabad, Tang-e Ghuchan, 1500 m, Zaeifi & Assadpour 2047; Bandarabbas, S. side of Kuh-e Genu, 1000-1300 m, Wendelbo & Foroughi 15544; Bandarabbas, Fareghan, 1350-1600 m, Mozaffarian 44843; 22 km N. of Qotabad, S. side of tunnle, 1200-1250 m, Wendelbo & Foroughi 15782. -Kerman: 122 km from Hajiabad, on the road to Esfandagheh, Abdasht, Assadi 25278.

The name Caralluma tuberculata is used for the first time from Iran. It is locally named Mogh-e mar and Marmutk. It is distributed from Pakistan, Punjab and Baluchistan to S. Iran.

It grows on rocky mountains or stony slopes.

Key to the species

1. Stem tapering toward the apex,

subterete, 60 cm long or more.

Flowers axillary, on long pedicels

C. edulis

- Stem angular, 15 cm long. Flowers terminal C. tuberculata
